

Frequently Asked Questions for Applicants and Inquiries

1) Am I eligible to apply?

Yes. Our Executive programs (MSBA, MSPM, MBA–Healthcare) are designed for working professionals. Admission is based on your academic record and the required documents below.

2) What documents are required for acceptance?

All applicants (everyone):

- Passport (bio page)
- U.S. visa (if applicable)
- Any U.S. transcripts (if you studied in the U.S.)

If your bachelor's degree is from outside the U.S.:

- Official course-by-course evaluation with GPA sent directly to TWU by one of the approved agencies:
 - a.WES https://www.wes.org/
 - b.ECE https://www.ece.org/
 - c.IERF https://ierf.org/
 - d. Educational Perspectives https://edperspective.org/
 - e.SpanTran https://spantran.com/
- English proficiency (only if you do NOT hold a U.S. bachelor's degree):
 - TOEFL 550 (paper) / 213 (computer) / 79 (iBT), or
 - o IELTS 5.5, or
 - Duolingo 95, or
 - Proof of successful completion of an approved ESL program or U.S. college composition credit (passing grade).

If your bachelor's degree is from the U.S.:

- Official U.S. transcripts
- (No external evaluation or English proficiency required.)

3) Where do I send documents?

- Official transcript evaluations → admissions@tnwesleyan.edu (sent by the evaluation agency)
- Unofficial eval copies + passport/visa + other docs → execgrad@tnwesleyan.edu

4) What is the application process?

- · Submit the online application.
- Upload passport/visa (if applicable).
- Request official evaluation (if international degree) or send official U.S. transcripts.
- Submit English proficiency only if you do not hold a U.S. bachelor's degree.
- We review once your file is complete and email the decision.

5) How long does a decision take?

Typically 5–7 business days after all required items are received.

6) Do you offer Day-1 CPT and OPT?

- MSBA and MSPM are STEM-designated (eligible for 12 months OPT + 24-month STEM extension, per federal rules).
- MBA Healthcare is not STEM.
- Day-1 CPT may be available in the Executive format; authorization is term-by-term once you're full-time and submit the employer letter + CPT form. (CPT cannot be backdated.)

7) Do you provide student health insurance?

TWU does not offer a university health plan. Students arrange private coverage independently.

8) Where are on-site sessions held?

Each term includes one on-site weekend at our West Knoxville campus; the rest is designed for working professionals.

9) How do I start the I-20 (after admission)?

Complete the I-20 items in our portal:

https://portal.tnwesleyan.edu/ICS/Executive_Program_Forms.jnz

(You'll upload financial proof and, if applicable, CPT forms there.)

10) What financial proof is required for the I-20?

A recent bank statement (and/or sponsor affidavit + bank statement) showing the required funding amount. Pay stubs can support your file but do not replace proof of liquid funds.

11) How does a SEVIS transfer affect OPT?

Your current school sets a SEVIS release date to TWU. OPT ends the same day the record releases. You may work under TWU CPT only on/after the CPT start date printed on your new TWU I-20.
